Step 1: Log in to your personal device with your login credentials.






## How will I log in to my YES Prep classes?

### Step 2: Sign into Microsoft Teams (if Teams is already downloaded on your device)

		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. If your computer already has Microsoft Teams installed, click on the Microsoft Teams icon pictured on the left here. If someone else uses the Teams program on your device or has signed into Teams previously, you will need to sign out. You can do by selecting your profile in the top right corner of the screen and scrolling down to 'Sign out'.</li> </ol>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2. Once you have signed out, reopen the Teams app and log in with your student's YES Prep email (listed on the Teams card on their bag and above).</li> </ol>		
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3. Enter your password. If you have not changed it, <b>the standard password is: YesStudents17</b></li> </ol>		

### Step 3: Sign into Microsoft Teams via Web Browser (if you do not have Teams downloaded on your computer)

<p><b>If you cannot access Microsoft Teams through the icon you can s log in online.</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Open a web browser (Chrome, if at all possible)       <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Go to portal.office.com</li> <li>b. Click on the logo in the top right corner to sign in.</li> <li>c. Then enter your Teams login name/email (on your student's login card. Click next.</li> <li>d. Enter your password. The standard password is: <b>YesStudents17</b></li> <li>e. Once you are fully logged in, you will see something like this:</li> </ol> </li> <li>2. Click on the Teams icon and get started!</li> </ol>	
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## How can I practice and be ready for Monday, August 24<sup>th</sup>?

### Step 4: Practice logging into a Teams meeting.

Make sure that your student can log into their Teams account and access a meeting by clicking a link BEFORE the first day of school on 8/24!

**We will have a test Teams meeting accessible to all students and parents from 12 pm on Saturday, 8/22 to 12 pm on Sunday, 8/23. Type this link into your device browser.**
