FORCE Updates

Common Assessments

Quarter 1 Common Assessments will be administered on October 28th-30th both virtually and in-person to accommodate both learning options. On Common Assessment days, students who opted into online learning, must join a live Teams Meeting AND must have their cameras on during the entire Teams Meeting. This will allow the proctor to provide your student with test directions, reminders of the time to test, overall support and ensure test security. If your student fails to turn on their camera during the examination period, your student's test will be paused until your student turns on their camera. No additional time will be provided for students who choose to not turn on their cameras and their tests will be submitted as is when the time to test is complete.

- They do not have a camera that works.
- They only have access to a mobile device. It is not possible for tests to be completed through a mobile device.
- If you desire that they test on campus.

If you believe your virtual student should test on campus for any of the reasons indicated above, please reach out to Paula Chavez (paula.chavez@yesprep.org) no later than Monday, October 20th.

Visitor Policy

Early Student Pick Up

Families that need to pick up their student(s) for any reason outside of arrival and dismissal will call the front office and sign out their student(s) over the phone. The student(s) will be escorted out to your vehicle. The Gulfton staff member escorting the student(s) will be visually checking photo I.D. of the parent/guardian or approved emergency contact before releasing the student(s).

Reminders: Students in person and virtual follow the same class period schedule daily. Attendance, academic participation, and grading expectations for in person and virtual are <u>the same</u>. In person <u>and virtual</u> students are expected to attend all four classes daily and submit assignments on time. If your student is virtual, they have a live class call via Teams daily at 8:30 AM, 10:15 AM, 12:40 PM, and 2:15 PM and assignments to complete each period.

FORCE Safety Procedures

Safety and Return to School Procedures

FORCE families that have selected for their child to learn on campus please take a few minutes to read the following safety and return school procedures; that must be followed in order to keep students and staff safe.



All students will have their temperature checked by staff member before they exit vehicle. Students with temp above 100F will not be allowed to stay on campus. Car riders and student drivers should leave in their arrival vehicle. Keep in mind, that if your student rides with another family to campus; if one student in that vehicle has a temp above 100F then, they will all be asked to go home. They may still attend classes virtually.



Walkers and Bike Riders will have their temp check at the temp check stations.



All vehicles should enter the **main entrance gate starting at 8am**. After student has been given permission to exit the vehicle, student will go to the designated area to be checked for mask and sanitize hands.



Make sure student has mask on prior to arrival, student remains in the vehicle until they have been screened, and student must remain 6 feet apart as they walk into the main entrance.



School Hours will still be the same for both virtual and on campus learning 8:30AM-3:45PM.

- At 4pm any student that has not been picked up will be escorted to the gym and an admin staff will monitor social distance.
- At 4:15pm any student that has not been picked up will be escorted of campus grounds by admin staff.



Materials Student needs will be a mask (and a back-up one), Gulfton ID, **charged laptop and charger**, headphones, pencil/notebooks, water bottle (enough for the entire day).



Bus Routes will be attached to Parent Notes for families who have selected bus transportation for their child.

- Find the closest route to you and that is the stop that your child will be allowed to use.
- There will be only 1 student per seat.
- Please check your students temperate before they get on the bus.



Attendance Reminder

- Parents remember that if your student is following the on campus learning route he/she will need to provide documentation when they are absent.
- Student must stay true to their learning environment and follow that particular track. If the student is absent and completes their work virtually, they will still need to provide documentation for their absence as they follow an in-person track.
- Please make sure you are submitting excuse notes (doctor's notes, etc.) when your student is absent due to an appointment or illness; to excuse the absence for the day the student was out.
